### Information/Discussion Item #2

#### Tennis Court Resurfacing Project

Davy Broom, Town Manager, explained that Staff had previously provided a bid for the resurfacing of the tennis courts located at the YMCA at the Complex facility. This quote was for resurfacing the courts in their current location. The quote was in the amount of \$260,006. Staff was asked to provide a bid to have the tennis courts restructured to fit the rendering provided by ESP and Associates that included a gymnasium. Mr. Broom provided Council with the quote for resurfacing of four (4) tennis courts in their current location and the construction of four (4) new courts for a total of eight courts. The amount for this is \$384,032. He also provided the rendering for their viewing. He stated the neither quote includes the cost to upgrade lighting, fencing or construction of restrooms, office space, and/or dressing rooms. This was for their information only at this time.

#### Fort Mill Farmer's Market – Overview of first weekend

Mrs. Jacona Hester gave council an update on the first weekend opening of the Fort Mill Farmer's Market. She said that Kona Ice gave out 170 snow cones. They had 6 vendors and over 400 people visit last Saturday. Most vendors sold out. They currently have an average of 6-12 vendors already signed up the upcoming Saturdays until the close on Labor Day weekend. She said that they share the list of vendors before each Saturday on the Town's website and on social media so that citizens will know who will be there before coming out.
