- **ADULT ENRICHMENT CENTER-RENEW MEMORY CARE**

Renew offers Montessori programming for adults with dementia, Alzheimer's, or age related cognitive delays. - **BETHEL SHELTERS**

The Men's Warming Center started in the winter of 2007 as a seasonal warming center for homeless men to find a warm meal and a safe place to sleep each night. Originally established through a partnership with the Salvation Army, United Way of York County, and the City of Rock Hill, the Men's Overnight Shelter gained a permanent home in 2009 at Bethel United Methodist Church, where it remains today. As the need for homelessness services continued to grow in the tricounty area (York, Chester, and Lancaster Counties), the Bethel Men's Warming Center began sheltering more and more men each season. Because of this tremendous need and the commitment of Bethel, its partners, and passionate community members, in April of 2019, rather than close its doors as it does at the end of each warming season, the Bethel Men's Warming Center remained open and officially became the Bethel Men's Shelter, the first and only year-round emergency shelter in the tri-county area. In 2021, Bethel Men's Shelter expanded its mission and began operations at the Bethel Day Shelter, a daytime shelter for men and women located at Pathways Community Center in Rock Hill. The Day Shelter operates 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. every day, and provides laundry services, showers and restroom facilities, lockers, respite, and partners with other agencies to connect clients to needed services. With the addition of this new program, Bethel Men's Shelter officially changed its name in 2022 to Bethel Shelters. <https://bethelshelters.org/>

- **CLASSROOM READY**

Classroom Ready is a Foundation for Fort Mill Schools program, run by community volunteers and funded by donations from our supportive community. Classroom Ready provides free school supplies to students in need who are enrolled in the Fort Mill School District. They serve students with a financial need in the Fort Mill School District. In the summer months, they work with individual families. The Fort Mill Care Center is more than a food pantry. In addition to providing food, personal hygiene and household cleaning supplies, they also assist with utilities, prescriptions and emergency dental for the residents of Fort Mill and Tega Cay, South Carolina.
