



## UNITY CEMETERY

Property of the Town of Fort Mill

### **VISITORS TO THE CEMETERY MUST OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING RULES**

#### **NON-MONUMENTAL SECTION**

- No permanent items can be placed on a plot without prior approval of the Fort Mill Public Works Supervisor. The General Rule allow only items which are flush with ground and will be limited to headstone and plot boundaries.
- Items such as coping, benches, or statues are strictly prohibited.

#### **MONUMENTAL SECTION**

- Prior approval of any placement must be obtained from the Fort Mill Public Works Supervisor.
- Items will be restricted to a tombstone, headstone, and plot boundaries.

#### **PRE-EXISTING ITEMS**

- Any plot which has pre-existing monuments, coping, fencing, etc., in place on the effective date of this ordinance will be grandfathered in on the condition that it be maintained in an appropriate condition.
- In the event items are not kept in an appropriate state, they will, after a reasonable effort to contact the family or family representative, be removed.

#### **REMOVAL OF ITEMS**

- Twice yearly, the last full week in February and the last week in July, all non-permanent items such as vases, artificial flowers, statues, etc., will be removed from the cemetery. The only items that will be allowed to remain will be those items previously approved by the Fort Mill Public Works Supervisor.
