



FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE- Town Finalizes Purchase of Two Historic Downtown Properties

May 30, 2024— The Town of Fort Mill is pleased to announce it has finalized the purchase of two historic buildings in Downtown Fort Mill.

The Town now owns the buildings at 123 and 205 North White Street, which were previously home to the Springs Executive Office and the Springs Research and Development Center.

Sitting adjacent to the Town’s Amphitheater and Walter Y. Elisha Park is the former Executive Office at 205 N. White St. The Town plans to occupy the building with Town Staff, the Fort Mill Police Department, a Council Chambers, a Municipal Court, conference rooms and training rooms. The former Research and Development Center is currently leased by Pike Incorporated and the lease has transferred to the Town.

The Town plans to complete maintenance, upgrades, and renovations to the facility before beginning to move staff into the facility by late 2024/early 2025. Both the current Town Hall Building and the current Police Department will be sold.
